The Convention Centre Dublin, Spencer Dock, North wall Quay, North Dock, Dublin 1, Ireland.

Located in the heart of Ireland's vibrant, popular and historic capital city, the CCD is just 15 minutes is in a convenient city centre location with excellent transport. It has a state of the art theatre/auditorium seating 2,000, 4,400 sqm (48,000 sqft) of Hall Space and 19 meeting and 4 board rooms seating 2,235 persons.
